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- 2) Home Goods, a furniture store, throws a weekend sale. They sell 4,456 pieces on Saturday and 2,919 pieces on Sunday. How many pieces of furniture do they sell in all?

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- 3) A delivery service company delivered 8,568 packages in one month and 6,789 packages in the next month. How many packages were delivered altogether?

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- 4) Hector, a philatelist, has 4,647 stamps in one album and 9,486 stamps in another. How many stamps are there in all?

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- 5) Mary spent \$1,600 on her rent and \$1,300 on her food and commute. How much money did she spend altogether?

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- 6) Bruce built a fort with 2,391 blocks. If he set up a palace using 2,293 blocks, how many blocks did he use altogether?

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
