1. The iodine-starch test is used to test the presence of carbohydrates. Place a slice of potato on a tray, and add two drops of iodine solution to the potato. The iodine on the potato will turn blue-black, indicating the presence of starch. Repeat the same experiment with bell pepper; it will turn yellow or orange, meaning there's no starch in it.
