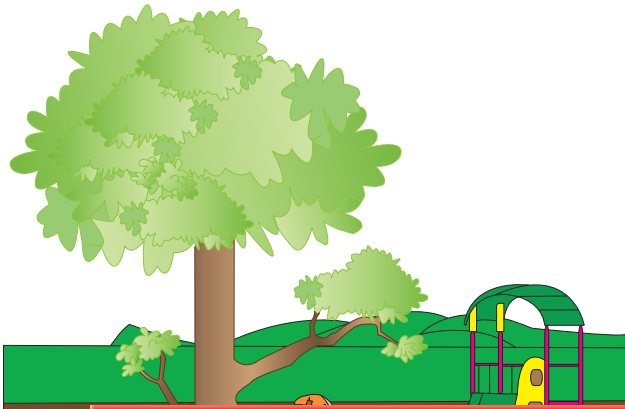


Squeak Another Day
