"Accept" is a verb that means "to take something offered" or "to recognize you're responsible for something".

Example: We are pleased to accept your invitation.

"Except" is both a preposition and conjunction, and it introduces the only person, thing, or fact that's not included in the main statement.

Example: Everybody did the coursework except Kevin.
