"Lose" is a verb, and it means "to no longer have a person/thing/a positive quality" or "not to win".

Example: You will fall if you lose your footing.

As an adjective, "loose" means "not firmly fixed", "readily available", or "not precise". As a verb, it means "to let/make loose".

Example: Randall pulled his tie loose.
