

Commonly Confused Words

"Their" is a possessive determiner meaning "belonging to them".

Example: Is this their house?

"They're" is the contraction of "they are".

Example: They're baking a cake for their grandma.

"There" is an adverb meaning "in/at/to that place". As a pronoun, it introduces the subject of a sentence.
