

Commonly Confused Words

“**Their**” is a possessive determiner meaning “belonging to them”.

Example: I gave them their books.

“**They’re**” is the contraction of “they are”.

Example: They’re very smart.

“**There**” is an adverb meaning “in/at/to that place”. As a pronoun, it introduces the subject of a sentence.
