Amendment 19: It gives women the right to vote.

Amendment 20: It moves the beginning and ending terms of President and Vice President from March 4 to January 20 and for members of Congress from March 4 to January 3. It also defines what is to be done when there is no president-elect.

Amendment 21: It repeals the 18th Amendment, making alcohol legal in the country again.

Amendment 22: It prohibits any individual who has been elected President twice from being elected again.

Amendment 23: It extends the right to vote in presidential elections to citizens residing in the District of Columbia.

Amendment 24: It abolishes poll tax for all federal elections.
