b) Gwen's performance in the recital was no good.

- 6) a) There weren't any houses here before.
b) There weren't no houses here before.

- 7) a) Didn't you cook nothing for the party?
b) Didn't you cook anything for the party?

- 8) a) The visitors weren't nowhere near the dilapidated house.
b) The visitors were nowhere near the dilapidated house.
