

# Dangling Modifiers

A dangling modifier modifies a word or phrase that is either placed too far from it or not clearly stated in a sentence.

**Example:** Having studied well, the exam was easy.

In this sentence, "having studied well" is a dangling modifier. According to the sentence, it's the exam that studies well, which we know is not the case.

**Having studied well, Jean found the exam easy.**

With the subject clearly stated and correctly placed, the sentence is easy to understand.
