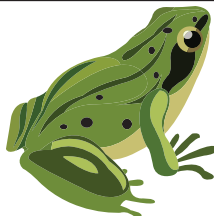
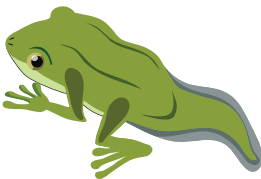
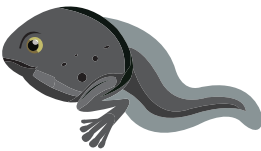
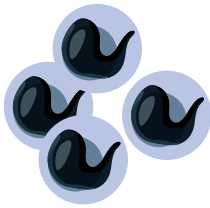
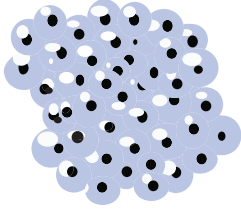


Matching Stages in Frog Life Cycle to Descriptions

Tadpole with hind legs: The tadpole sprouts hind legs first.

Tadpole with four legs: The tadpoles grow two tiny front legs, and the tail shrinks.

Froglet: The lungs are fully developed, and the gills disappear.

Tadpole: Each egg hatches into a tiny tadpole.

Eggs: The baby frogs begin their life as tiny black dots covered with a jelly-like substance.

Adult frog: The tail disappears. The frog jumps out of water and is ready to live on land.

Embryo: A tiny comma-shaped tadpole grows within each egg.
