

Active and Passive Voice

The difference between the active and passive voice revolves around the subject and verb of a sentence. When the subject is performing the verb, it is active voice. When the verb is performed upon the subject, it is passive voice.

Example: The garage is being cleaned by us.

We are cleaning the garage.
