Commas and Coordinate Adjectives

Coordinate adjectives are two or more adjectives that modify a noun independently. They are usually separated by a comma. Coordinate adjectives can be written in any order.

Example: Leonard is a cheerful well-behaved boy.

Leonard is a cheerful, well-behaved boy.
