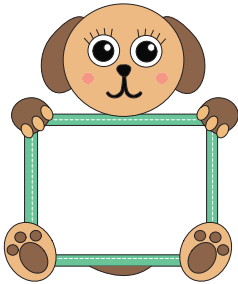


# Countable and Uncountable Nouns

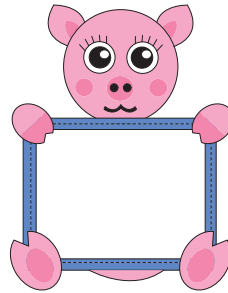
Nouns that we can count are called countable nouns.

Mark "C" for countable nouns and "U" for uncountable nouns.

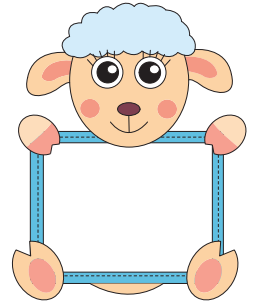
