Verb Phrases

A verb phrase consists of the main verb, any modal and/or auxiliary verbs, and modifiers. Verb phrases may also be phrases that function as adverbs or adjectives and contains a verb and its compliments and objects.

Example: Vivian couldn't believe the news at first.
