

# Helping Verbs / Modal Auxiliaries

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**A modal is an auxiliary or helping verb that demonstrates a necessity, ability, willingness, possibility, request, capacity, suggestion, order, obligation, advice, or permission. Words like may, might, must, can, could, shall, should, will, and would are modal auxiliaries that give additional information about the function of the main verb.**

**Example:** Kylie can do the dishes after lunch.
