- 1) Mother bought 5 large packets of spearmint bubble gum. If each packet contains 210 pieces, how many pieces are there altogether?

- 2) Laura sells home-made pizza sauce. If she uses 9 tomatoes to make one jar of sauce, how many tomatoes does she need to make 115 jars?

- 3) The small box can hold 120 blueberries. The large box has space for 3 times as many blueberries as the small box. How many blueberries are in the large box if it's filled to capacity?

- 4) If Eric solves 7 sudoku puzzles every week, how many puzzles will he solve in 112 weeks?

- 5) Suzie, a gifted sculptor, makes 2 sculptures a day. How many sculptures will she make in 365 days?

- 6) Ian is new to collecting marbles, but his brother Jake has been at it for a while. Ian has 102 marbles, and Jake has 8 times more marbles than Ian does. How many marbles are in Jake's collection?
