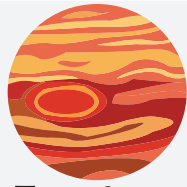

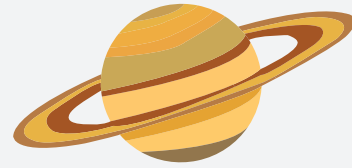

**Uranus, the seventh planet from the Sun, is the coldest planet in the solar system. Uranus, which has a thin ring system, has 27 known moons. It is described to be rolling around the Sun on its side.**

**Neptune, the eighth planet from the Sun, is the smallest of the gas giants. It has the strongest winds in the solar system. Neptune has 13 known moons, Triton being the largest.**
