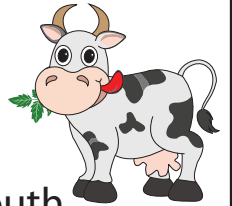

away from the driveway

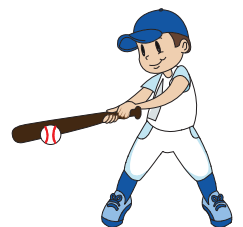
