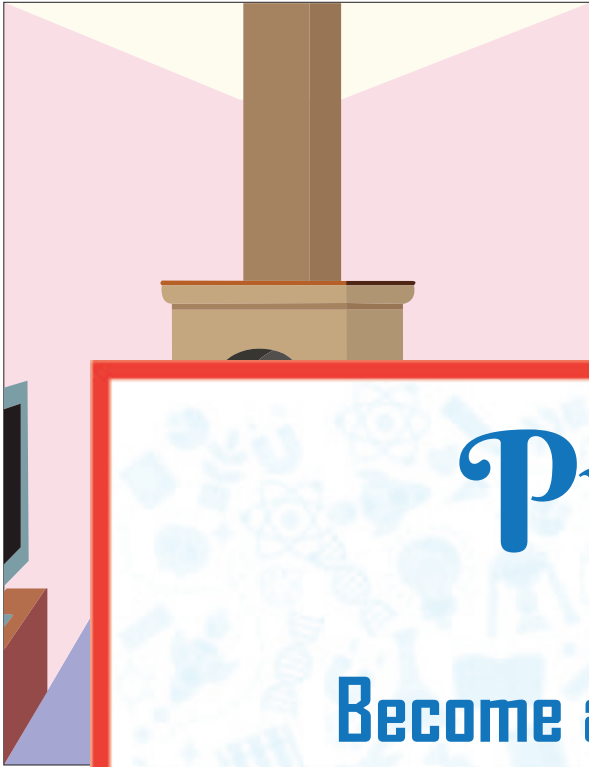


# The Great Hunter Cat
