1)

It is the evaporation of water from the plants. Plants release excess water from their leaves in the form of vapor or moisture.

2)

It is the process by which water in lakes, rivers, and oceans is converted from its liquid state to gaseous state.

3)

It is the transformation stage where vapor in the air gets converted to liquid. It is the reverse of evaporation.

4)

It is the movement of water into the deeper layers of the soil to reach the ground water.

5)

It is the process where liquid water or frozen water falls back to the earth in the form of rain, sleet, or snow.

6)

It is the excess water from rain, snow, or other sources of water that flows across the surface of the land and is not absorbed by the soil.

7)

It is the process by which water is collected in large bodies like lakes, ponds, and oceans.

8)

It is a process where ice directly converts into water vapor without converting into liquid water.
