Find the greatest common factor of each pair of numerals.

1) 2, 8

$$\text{GCF}(2, 8) = \underline{\quad 2 \quad}$$

2) 10, 20

$$\text{GCF}(10, 20) = \underline{\quad 10 \quad}$$

3) 24, 20

$$\text{GCF}(24, 20) = \underline{\quad 4 \quad}$$

4) 4, 14

$$\text{GCF}(4, 14) = \underline{\quad 2 \quad}$$

5) 16, 12

$$\text{GCF}(16, 12) = \underline{\quad 4 \quad}$$

6) 6, 21

$$\text{GCF}(6, 21) = \underline{\quad 3 \quad}$$

7) 11, 22

$$\text{GCF}(11, 22) = \underline{\quad 11 \quad}$$

8) 21, 14

$$\text{GCF}(21, 14) = \underline{\quad 7 \quad}$$

9) 20, 15

$$\text{GCF}(20, 15) = \underline{\quad 5 \quad}$$

10) 18, 24

$$\text{GCF}(18, 24) = \underline{\quad 6 \quad}$$
