Answer Key

$$1) \quad 5 \frac{1}{3} + 1 \frac{2}{3} = \underline{6 \frac{3}{3} = 7}$$

$$2) \quad 5 \frac{5}{12} + 4 \frac{8}{12} = \underline{9 \frac{13}{12} = 10 \frac{1}{12}}$$

$$3) \quad 2 \frac{1}{6} + 3 \frac{1}{6} = \underline{5 \frac{2}{6} \text{ or } 5 \frac{1}{3}}$$

$$4) \quad 8 \frac{3}{4} + 7 \frac{1}{4} = \underline{15 \frac{4}{4} = 16}$$

$$5) \quad 9 \frac{3}{8} + 3 \frac{5}{8} = \underline{12 \frac{8}{8} = 13}$$

$$6) \quad 3 \frac{3}{10} + 1 \frac{1}{10} = \underline{4 \frac{4}{10} \text{ or } 4 \frac{2}{5}}$$

$$7) \quad 6 \frac{3}{4} + 4 \frac{2}{4} = \underline{10 \frac{5}{4} = 11 \frac{1}{4}}$$

$$8) \quad 1 \frac{1}{2} + 7 \frac{1}{2} = \underline{8 \frac{2}{2} = 9}$$

$$9) \quad 2 \frac{9}{16} + 5 \frac{3}{16} = \underline{7 \frac{12}{16} \text{ or } 7 \frac{3}{4}}$$

$$10) \quad 9 \frac{3}{5} + 2 \frac{3}{5} = \underline{11 \frac{6}{5} = 12 \frac{1}{5}}$$
