

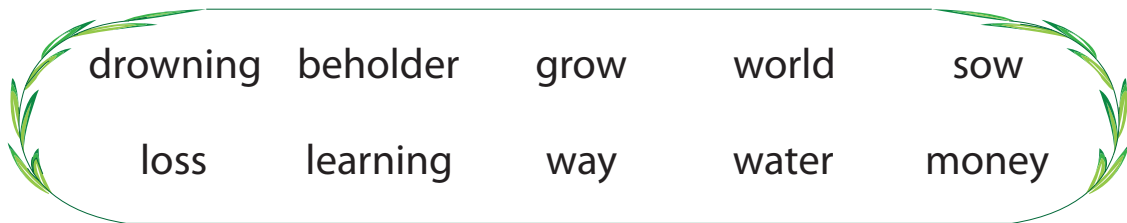
# Proverbs
