

Converting Temperatures | Celsius to Fahrenheit

A) Convert the temperatures from Celsius to Fahrenheit.

Example: Convert 23°C to °F.

$$F = 1.8 C + 32$$

$$= 1.8 (23) + 32 = 41.4 + 32 = 73.4^{\circ}\text{F}$$
