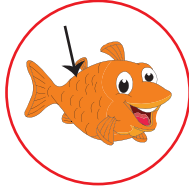
Homographs are words with the same spelling but different meanings. The pronunciation may or may not be different.

Example : Shane used four quarters to buy a soda.

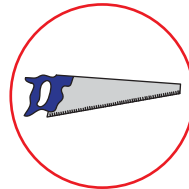


Circle the picture that matches the underlined homograph in each sentence.

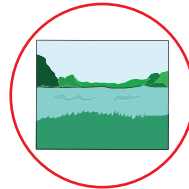
- 1) The goldfish has shiny scales.
