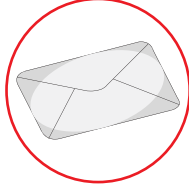
Homographs are words with the same spelling but different meanings. The pronunciation may or may not be different.

Example : John hurt his foot playing basketball.

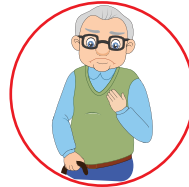
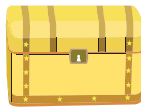

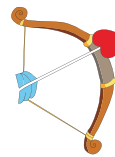
- 1) I received a letter from Grandma last week.
