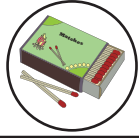


Homographs

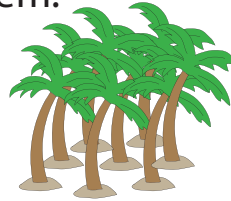
Homographs are words with the same spelling but different meanings. The pronunciation may or may not be different.

- 1) She rubbed her palms together to warm them.



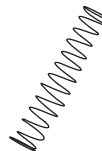
- 2) Millie prefers a pen to a pencil.
